3/15/73-CBS News, 7:00pm tonight featured a XX film report by Fred Graham on recent witnesses in the Ellsberg trial. He interviewed them outside the courthouse. One was Arthur Schlesinger. Graham's narration said something to the effect that Schlesinger testified that there was nothing in the Pentagon papers not previously disclosed except for the 1962 plan to withdraw from Vietnam. On film, Schlesinger, outside the courthouse, said that this document released in 1969 could have been of no aid to NVN, but that had it been released sooner, it could have prevented a lot of bloodshed. No details.

3/15/73-CBS News said that today the TSBD "from which LHO fired the shots that killed President Kennedy" was put up for sale to the highest bidder as a historical monument.
