Did Robert F. Kennedy make a secret deal with Nikita Khru-shchev to end the Cuban missile crisis?

That's what historian Arthur Schlesinger says in a forthcoming biography of Robert Kennedy. He says the deal was made at the behest of JFK. Schlesinger also intends to reveal the origin of the CIA's assassination plans during Eisenhower's term of service, plans that continued into the Kennedy years



without the knowledge of the head of the CIA, according to Schlesinger. The author, who was Robert Kennedy's close friend, also says RFK was "skeptical" of the Warren Commission's conclusions.
