Statement of Witnesses - Mrs. VIRGINIA DAVIS, 19 H 562

The statement is dated "Today November 22, 1963".

"about 1:30 pm my sister-in-law and /m myself were lying down in our apartment. ... We heard a shot and then another shot and ran to side door at Patton Street. I saw the boy cutting across our yard and he was unloading his gun." Her sister-inlaw, Jeanette, called the police.

"Jeanette found a empty shell that the man had unloaded and gave it to the police. After the Police had left I found a empty shell in our yard. This is the same shell I gave to Detective Dhority. The man that was unloading the gun was the same man that I saw tonight as number 2 in a line up."

Note first, she heard only 2 shots; also, the wrong time period.

They found 2 shells. As I recall the radio log, the police called and were looking for 2 more shells. I have yet to see how the police knew they should be looking for 2 more empty shelks. I know of they could have heard things from the hospital and things like that, but there is no evidence of how they knew, ifixk indeed they did know.
