

Tippit's Widow Is Remarried

DALLAS, Tex., Jan. 29 (AP) — Mrs. J. D. Tippit, the widow of a Dallas policeman killed shortly after President Kennedy was assassinated, has remarried.

Dallas police Lt. Harry Dean Thomas said last night that he and Mrs. Tippit were married a week ago. They are residing in Dallas. She has three children and he has four.

Donors from all over the world gave Mrs. Tippit more than \$650,000 in contributions after her husband was slain by accused presidential assassin Lee Harvey Oswald.
