Dear Penn,

It is my understanding, through a reliable informant, that Tippit's brother is dead. I have been watching the Mirror for details but none have been forthcoming. I hope that if my informant is correct, you will be filling us in some time in the near future. Needless to say, Tippit is one of the great unknowns of the assassination, and his family has provided practically no information which could be of any use in clearing up the mysteries of his death, assuming that they are very likely related to the assassination itself.
