

Tonahill Indicted

AUSTIN, Tex.—Joe Tonahill, Jasper (Tex.) lawyer who once defended James H. Byrd, has been indicted on federal charges of evading

\$4732 in income taxes from 1960 through 1962.

Tonahill pleaded innocent before U.S. District Judge Roberts and went free on \$5000 bond.

The three-count indictment was returned April 14, and was unsealed only yesterday.
