

Miami Herald, prior to 9/6/63, re Fernando Fernandez (Barcena), a spy in the Christian Democratic Movement and a story about a confession have been wrung from him by threats and torture. Also, possibility of same in Miami News.

Either or both papers (or NYTimes) story on meeting of Interamerican Press Assn and speech to the effect that there would be developments within a few days that should teach the US that its policy of peaceful coexistence with Cuba was wrong, about 11/19/63.

Raids on Cuba about 8/10/63, especially involving Russians in Hotel Rosita de Hornedo, Ist. Ave. and "O" St., Havana (Miramar); refineries at Bellot, Havana Bay; Maranjito power station. Also, there were raids, I think by sea, that resulted in attacks on Russian or the hotels in which they lived.
