Three Sentenced on Coast In Alleged Kidnapping Plot

LOS ANGELES, May 29(AP) — A former member of the Charles Manson clan and two county jail inmates have been sentenced to varying prison terms on conspiracy charges stemming from an alleged plot to kidnap a consular official here.

Maria Theresa Alonzo, 23 years old, a follower of Charles Manson, a convicted murderer, was sentenced yesterday to six months in prison and five years probation. Garrett Brock Trapnell, 36, and Robert Bernard Hedberg Jr., 37, were sentenced to prison terms of 15 years and five years, respectively.

Mr. Trapnell is serving a life sentence for an airliner hijacking in 1972 in which he is alleged to have demanded payment of \$308,000 and the release of Angela Davis, black militant, and an unidentified inmate of a Dallas jail.

Mr. Hedberg is awaiting trial on charges of assaulting a police officer in a shootout last January.
