Woman Held in Consul-Kidn

One person has been arrested and two others charged with conspiring to kidnap and hold as hostage a foreign consul general in Los Angeles, the FBI announced yesterday.

A statement issued by FBI Director Clarence M. Kelley said the aim of the would-be kidnapers was to obtain the release of two persons confined in the Los Angeles County jail.

The person arrested was listed by the FBI as Theresa Alonzo, 22, who agents picked up at her Hollywood, Calif., apartment.

The statement said she was charged with conspiring with Garrett Brock Trapnell and Robert Bernard Hedberg Jr. to effect the kidnaping. Hedberg and Trapnell are now confined to the Los Angeles County jail, the statement said.

The complaint charges that the three conspired to kidnap the consul general of one of the following countries: Estonia, Paraguay, Uruguay, Canada, France, Germany, Switzerland or Haiti.
