

Producer Julian Bercovici belatedly admitted he had not had discussions with the mother and widow of the late Lee Harvey Oswald in regard to a film he is planning, "The Trial Of Lee Harvey Oswald." Bercovici had made a contrary claim in an article published in the Nov. 19 issue of *Variety*. Marguerite Oswald, mother of the accused assassin of President John F. Kennedy, in a telephone interview from her home in Fort Worth said, "I was indignant, but it has happened before, I suppose that's the price you pay when you become a public figure; people take advantage of you."

Bercovici admitted, "No contact had been made with Marguerite," and added, "The same is true for Marina (the widow)." He had said he expected their cooperation with the planned film.
