

ABC's "The Trial of Lee Harvey Oswald"... which has been getting unfavorable editorial comment around the country... didn't do all that well with viewers, according to A.C. Nielsen "overnights" in New York, Los Angeles and Chicago on Friday and Sunday nights.

On Friday, "Oswald" led NBC's "The Rockford Files" in all three cities but "Quincy" took over from 10 o'clock on... as CBS trailed in all three markets between 9 and 11.

On Sunday... the debut on CBS of "All in the Family," "Alice" and "Kojak" manhandled "Oswald" in New York... NBC's "Just a Little Inconvenience" outscored "Oswald" in Los Angeles but "Oswald" won the 9-to-11 time period in Chicago.

Outgoing FCC Chairman Richard E. Wiley, who will probably leave office next week... will head the Washington office of the Chicago law firm of Kirkland, Ellis & Rowe... acting FCC general counsel Lawrence Secret will go with him... as an associate firm member.
