Hello Harold,

It was nice of you to write. Of all the people involved in this travesty of mine you were the only person kind enough (concerned?) to write anything. Maybe I am feeling sorry for myself. Usually, I get hacked as hell when I get taken, but this time I let myself get greatly wrapped up in what was taking place. Thank God, too, the editor for whom I was writing took his time.

Your letter was appreciated, although I confess I am not sure I knew to whom you were alluding sometimes. Also, I am not sure to whom you were giving gentle hell. I am not sure who was the ~~funny~~ fool, fooler, and foolee in this case. I think I could qualify for the first and last terms in this mess.

Do you know Professor Ford? From all his documents, letters to me, published interviews, and telephone conversations I will SWEAR I reported quite accurately what he had said was his news message. The documents mentioned refer to a purported FBI document which links a young Cong. Nixon with a labor organizer named Rubinstein. This is supposed to be HUAC stuff, circa. 1947. I do not know if it is valid and was trying to explain this to Trowbridge Ford when he hung up on me. I understand there MAY have been two Rubinsteins (that seems odd, like two Oswalds). No, I am not unhappy about my violence seminar. I had postponed it partly because I had a shakey ~~fix~~ feeling I was not on very solid ground as a "scholar," much less as a journalist. Finances caused some trouble, too. You are correct--I would have been in a bit of a bind. I am taking your advice and ignoring the whole thing for the present.
