The only alternative I see is for Ms Stansfield to call me, pretty much at her convenience.

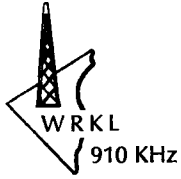
Generally this time of the year I'm the only one home daytimes except weekends.
