Haven't had a chance to read this a.m.'s papers, but the Post has a p. 1 headline on what I heard on ~~radio~~ ABC last night, and WTOP radio played it heavily this a.m. (all-news radio). This afternoon's radio news says the Panthers are joining with whites in observation of King's assassination. At last, the light! But can any of it shine here?
