Dear Russ,

From your last letter, I should have one from you tomorrow, so this is brief, to enclose this part of a clipping that rounds out the story on Groth a bit, not inconsistently with what I have been suggesting, and to tell you that I now have a suppressed FBI report of 12/9/63, making no direct reference to the interview reports of which I sent you copies, and saying that the only arrest in connection with the President's planned visit was that of Vallee, named.

Thus, if the FBI is to be believed, there is no doubt at all about the nature of and the reason for this arrest and there is doubt about the ^Bolden story, at least its timing. Which can explain his refusal to respond and that of his wife. The quality of this report is too poor for copying. I now know the files in which it is and will attempt to get a better one. If I do, I'll send you a copy.
