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

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Patn. Arthur Levet reports of investigating an auto accident on Metairie Road, about 2000 feet downtown of Fairway Drive on November 3, 1967 about 12:20 PM.

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Driver of vehicle $\frac{\pi}{2}$ 2 said she was operating her Motor Scooter downtown on Metairie Road and after crossing the 17th Street Canal, she changed over from the right lane into the left lane and passed vehicle $\frac{\pi}{2}$ 1, which appeared to be stopping. After traveling in the left lane, for some distance, vehicle $\frac{\pi}{2}$ 1 overtook her from in the right lane and when setting alongside of her, suddenly cut over into her lane causing her motorscooter to strike the neutral ground curb throwing her off with her face striking the curbing and neutral ground. Vehicle $\frac{\pi}{2}$ 1 fled the scene.

Driver of wehicle # 2 further said that witness # 2 stopped and gave her a business card with his name and phone number. He also give her the license plate number of vehicle # 1.

Witness $\frac{\pi}{4}$ 1 said he was traveling behind vehicle $\frac{\pi}{4}$ 1 and as they crossed the 17th Street Canal into Orleans Farish, vehicle $\frac{\pi}{4}$ 1 applied brakes slowing almost to a stop. At that time vehicle $\frac{\pi}{4}$ 2 passed vehicle $\frac{\pi}{4}$ 1 and continued straight ahead in the traffic lane next to the neutral ground. Vehicle $\frac{\pi}{4}$ 1 picked up speed overtaking vehicle $\frac{\pi}{4}$ 2 from the right then suddenly cut over into the neutral ground traffic lane almost striking vehicle $\frac{\pi}{4}$ 2 and forcing the driver into the neutral ground curb. Driver of vehicle $\frac{\pi}{4}$ 2 was thrown off the vehicle and vehicle $\frac{\pi}{4}$ 1 fled the scene and stormed about one block further down Metairie Road. The driver got out of vehicle $\frac{\pi}{4}$ 1, then cut back into it again and drove away.

Registration obtained from Auto Theft and vehicle $\frac{d}{dt}$ l registered to A. F. Backer Jr., No. 32 Allard Blvd., for a 1966 Cadillac.

Investigating Officer went to # 32 Allard Blvd. and spoke to the maid who cojtacted Mrs. Backer by phone. Mrs. Backer said she would have Mr. Backer contact the investigating Officer at Police Headquarters.

On November 3, 1967, at 2:00 PM Mr. Backer contacted the investigating Officer by telephone.

Mr. Backer stated that he owns the vehicle in question and he was on Metairie Road when the Motor Scooter struck the curbing. However, he was in no way involved or caused the driver to strike the curb. Mr. Backer further stated that he was traveling in the right lane and behind vehicle # 2 which was traveling in the left lane. The driver of vehicle # 2 turned her head towards the rear and was straightening, some books that were tiedon a luggage rack. At that time the driver lost control and struck the curb. He came to a stop about one half blockaway and got out of his car to see if the driver of velicle # 2 was oK. After seeing the driver of

wehicle $\frac{\#}{2}$ standing up on the neutral ground, he got into his car and drove on as she did not appear to need help.

Vehicle # 1 was checked by Officer and there was no evidence to show cont ct with vehicle # 2.

Vitness $\frac{d}{dt}$ 2 was contacted by phone and he stated that he was traveling towards Metairie on Metairie Road when he saw vehicle $\frac{d}{dt}$ 2 turn over on its side and the driver on the injured obviously on the neutral ground. He also saw vehicle $\frac{d}{dt}$ 1 stopped in the right hand traffic lane ahe d of which $\frac{d}{dt}$ 2. The driver got into vehicle $\frac{d}{dt}$ 1 and drove away. He wrote down the license plate number of vehicle $\frac{d}{dt}$ 1 in case it was involved in the accident. He then offered assistance to the driver of vehicle $\frac{d}{dt}$ 2 and gave her the license number of vehicle $\frac{d}{dt}$ 2 that vehicle $\frac{d}{dt}$ 1 caused the accident. Witness $\frac{d}{dt}$ 2 further stated that he did not witness the accident but arrived on the scene just after it occurred.

On November 15, 1967 Mr. T. Gireud, Assistant Attorney for Traffic Court, Section A, was consulted in this matter.

Mr. Giraud advised that there we sinsufficient evidence to charge the driver of vehicle $\frac{\mu}{\pi}$ l with fleeing the scene of an accident, however, Mr. Giraud accepted charges arainst the driver of vehicle $\frac{\mu}{\pi}$ l for violation of Ordinance 828 MCS 38:99 relative to reckless driving.

On November 15, 1967 affidevit No. D-254123 was filed against the driver of vehicle # 1, Mr. A. F. Backer Jr., charging him with reckless driving.
