A split way hole? →



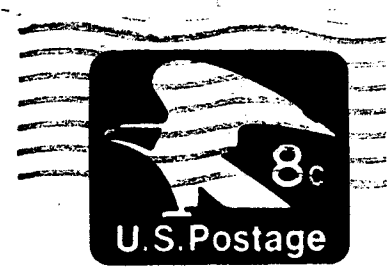
