Frenchman denies any involvement in JFK death

LONDON — A British television program claimed three French gangsters assassinated President John F. Kennedy on a contract from U.S. organized crime, but French records show two of them were not in Dallas on Nov. 22, 1963.

A third man, Sauveur Poronti in an interview with the newspaper Marseilles displayed a military record showing he was based in Toulon on a mine sweeper at the time of the assassination.
