Possible Witness to Ruby-Oswald Link

CE 2307 reports that on November 23, 1963 at 11:44 pm a call was made from Ruby's phone in the Carousel Club to SO 3-8022, Galveston, Texas. It is noted that the call was placed to Billy Ray Wilson aka Breck Wall, and that the number is listed to one Thomas J. McKenna, 1527 Broadway, Galveston.

It is of course a source of curiosity as to what Wilson was doing in Galveston at that time, since he was continuously registered at the Adolphus Hotel from August to February.

Referring to the testimony of Wilber (Bob) Litchfield to the effect that he had been to the Carousel to see Ruby one afternoon, apparently the same afternoon Alex Gruber was there (November 11), and while there saw Oswald waiting also, it is noted that Litchfield described a third man in the waiting room who was from ~~Kansas~~ Galveston. He said this man was large and flamboyant, flashily dressed. The man said he was in Dallas on his honeymoon. It is entirely possible that this third man is Thomas McKenna.

It would seem desirable to question McKenna as to whether he saw Oswald on that day in the Carousel, why Wilson was at his place on the 23rd, and whether there was any contact by David Ferrie on his whirlwind trip of that weekend.
