SUBJECT: SEIZURE OF EXPLOSIVES - LACOMBE, AUGUST 1963

One of the names on the list furnished by William Burvich is ACELO PEDROS AMORES. Thayer Waldo says that PEDRO AMORES is not a common name. He says he knew a PEDRO AMORES in the 1940s in Cuba. This man was a Batista henchman who made an ostensible break with Batista but actually was an infiltrator of the Castro movement. When Castro came to power he continued the cover by getting into labor unions, but finally fled Cuba with forged papers in 1961 or so because of the effectiveness of Castro counter agents in ferreting out infiltrators.
