Ramparts Magazine has come across information which will be published in the forthcoming issue concerning the assassination of Che Guevarra in Bolivia. We seem to have documented fairly well that Che was not killed in the ambush of a guerilla unit, but that he was captured with minor injuries and later executed by his captors. What buttresses this is that fact that like in the case of the Warren Commission, the Bolivian government will not release even to his brother from Buenos Aires either autopsy photographs or reports. The information we have is that his execution in custody was ordered by the C.I.A., specifically two men in the employ of the agency. They are FELIX RAMOS, age 26 and single, bearing a passport of unknown nationality, no. 0152052, and EDUARDO GONZALES, age 32, single, bearing a passport of unknown nationality, No A8093737. One of these men supposedly is Cuban, the other Puerto Rican. This has not been verified nor is there any indication of whether it is RAMOS or GONZALES who is the Cuban.

There is attached a photograph of one or the other of these men. You may wish to include it in photographs shown to possible witnesses as the possibility exists these men were in one of the C.I.A. structures of this investigation.
