RE: JULES ROCCO KIMBLE

On this date I received a telephone call from EARL McCREA of the Toronto Daily Star, 80 King Street West, Toronto, Ontario. I had previously furnished McCREA information and leads concerning Canadian aspects of the investigation which appeared in my article in the January Ramparts. Specifically, I furnished him the address 3420 St. Germain Street, Montreal, telephone 522-6530, which reportedly was used by KIMBLE when he fled to Montreal under CIA aegis last summer. I requested McCREA to report to us whatever information he might develop.

He said that he went to that address which is a rooming house and talked to the landlady who speaks broken English. She did say that KIMBLE had lived there in 1962 and 1963 and 1964 for various periods of time. He did not return until suddenly in 1967 at the beginning of Expo the Montreal World's Fair. The landlady remarked, "He comes. He goes. He keeps getting phone calls and visitors." According to the landlady KIMBLE said he had a sister in Missouri, owned oil wells in Missouri, and while he was in Montreal last summer was driving a red convertible. She said that when he left he stole her radio.
