[REDACTED] WHOSE IDENTITY MUST BE PROTECTED, STATES HE CANNOT REVEAL HIS SOURCE OF INFORMATION WHO FURNISHED HIM INFORMATION ABOUT DALLAS DISTRICT ATTORNEY HENRY WADE BEING CALLED TO APPEAR BEFORE PRESIDENT'S COMMISSION IN CONNECTION WITH ALLEGATION THAT OSWALD WAS ON PAYROLL OF FBI. STATES HIS SOURCE IS RELIABLE AND HAS INFERRED SOURCE IS IN OR CLOSE TO DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE. [REDACTED] WAS ADVISED THAT THE STORY CONCERNING OSWALD BEING ON THE FBI PAYROLL WAS ERRONEOUS AND THAT HE SHOULD SO INSTRUCT HIS SOURCE.

AT TIME OF ABOVE CONTACT [REDACTED] STATED HIS SOURCE ADVISED HIM LAST NIGHT THAT DISTRICT ATTORNEY HENRY WADE AND HIS ASSISTANT BILL ALEXANDER HAD DEPARTED FOR WASHINGTON, DC, IN LATE AFTERNOON AND WERE SCHEDULED TO LEAVE WASHINGTON AT FIVE THIRTY PM TODAY FOR RE-

I PERSONALLY ENDEAVORED TO CONTACT MR. WADE AT HIS OFFICE, AND WAS ADVISED HE WOULD NOT BE AVAILABLE UNTIL LATE AFTERNOON.

FIDENTIALLY THAT A SOURCE OF HIS ON JAN. TWENTYTWO LAST ADVISED THAT  
DISTRICT ATTORNEY HENRY WADE HAD SUPPOSEDLY RECEIVED CALL FROM PRESI-  
DENT'S COMMISSION TO APPEAR IMMEDIATELY IN WASHINGTON, DC, CONCERN-  
ING INFORMATION WADE ALLEGEDLY HAD THAT OSWALD WAS ON FBI PAYROLL  
AT TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS PER MONTH AND HAD A CODE NAME AND NUMBER AS-  
SIGNED TO HIM, AND THAT SA HOSTY (REFERENCE TO SA JAMES P. HOSTY)  
WAS SUPPOSEDLY A NON-EXISTENT PERSON AND WAS JUST A CODE NAME USED  
BY THE FBI.

DISTRICT ATTORNEY WADE ADVISED HE HAD NEVER RECEIVED ANY SUCH  
INFORMATION AND HAD NEVER GIVEN OUT ANY SUCH INFORMATION AND DENIED  
KNOWING ANYTHING ABOUT IT.

WADE ADVISED HE WOULD LET ME KNOW SHOULD HE RECEIVE ANY INFOR-  
MATION ALONG THE ABOVE LINES SO THAT THE SOURCE OF SAME COULD BE

CHECKED OUT.

Dallas teletype of 1/23/64 referred to information furnished the Dallas Office by [redacted] indicating that District Attorney Henry Wade had supposedly received a call from the President's Commission to appear immediately in Washington, D. C. regarding information Wade allegedly had that Oswald was on the FBI payroll at \$200 per month and had a code name and number assigned to him and that SA Hosty was supposedly a non-existent person and was just a code name used by the FBI.

SAC Shanklin of Dallas was telephonically advised today to contact [redacted] and advise him that this story was completely without foundation and to try and obtain from [redacted] the source of his information in order that this source could be straightened out.

Shanklin was told that in the event [redacted] refused to divulge his source, [redacted] should be requested to contact his source and straighten out this individual as to the true facts in order that this rumor would not be spread any further.
