The following investigation was conducted by SAs PAUL L. SCOTT and RICHARD E. HARRISON:

On January 25, 1964. ANTRONY R. WYMEN, Controller, Sheraton-Dallas Hotel, Southland Conter, Dallas, advised after Checking records that WILLIAM W. TUDDER, 35 Alpine Terrace, San Prancisco, California, with McEddden Publications, registered at the hotel at 1:39 PM on 11/25/63. He checked out at 8:31 AM on November 27, 1963. The records showed long-distance phone call 11/26/63, charge \$2.92, to WARNER, washington, D. C., number 10 4-5985, at 2:39 PM, time 2 minues.

h long-distance cell was made on 11/27/63 at 8:41 AM to Silverman, New York, 10. 532-9050, time 11 minutes, charge \$7.10. The records reflected 80 cents for local calls 11/27/63. But numbers to which calls made not recorded by hotel. The record bore a notation AF 001-205-212-2, and WYMAN advised this was an American Express credit card number used by TURNER for identification.

WYMAN subsequently advised SA PAUL L. SCOTT on 1/27/64. after checking reservation records, that reservations were made 11/24/63 by Hotels Motels Reservation Center, 98 Post Street, San Francisco; California, for TURNER, scheduled to arrive Dallas at noon on 11/25/63. Reservations were requested for three nights.

The registration card contained no notation that TURNER was issued a courtesy parking card, and, therefore, the shotel assumed he arrived by means other than automobile.
