2d Bulgarian Dies in London

LONDON—A Bulgarian defector working for the British Broadcasting Corp. has been found dead, the BBC said last night. The body of Vladimir Simeonov, 30, was found by a neighbor in his London home after he failed to arrive at work yesterday. Police said the case was being treated as a suspicious death.

Police investigating the death last month of another Bulgarian defector employed by the BBC, Georgi Markov, 49, said he had been killed by a minute poisoned ball smaller than a pinhead.

Markov said before he died he had been stabbed with the poisoned tip of an umbrella in a London street.
