Hughes, as strange, paranoidal acquisitive man, was in a unique position to profit personally from his services to the CIA. He owned his vast industrial conglomerate personally. This gave him absolute personal gontrol or all facilities that could be used by the pols and spooks and gave him the personally all profit and other benefits he could expect and did get. One example came to light in March, 1975, when the CIA and FBI were under strong criticism for transgressions xxxxxxxxx against the law, Constituion and the personal freedom of Americans from their illicit, police-state domestic operations. CIA had engaged in a secret, costplus contract with Hughes' empire to build a xpixxx special ship for the recovery of objects from unprecedented ocean depths. The Glomar Explorer, named after tughes' Gismar Global Marine company, retrieved parts of a Soviet submarine from more than three miles down in the Pacific. Hughes was paid all costs plus a profit and remained the owner of the unique vessel. Colson had leaked an indication of this project in speaking of this ship as the "Glomar Express."
