DETAILS

SYNOPSIS

FEI, Philadelphia, investigated this case and the allegations implied by the Cukowski's appear to be unfounded. Case closed.

DETAILS OF INVESTIGATION

Reference is made to M/R of SAIC Lane Bertram, Houston, dated December 17, 1963. This report related that several calls were made by Mr. and Mrs. Stan Cukowski, Village Green, Pa., to Juvenile Officer Larry Hauch, Conroe, Texas, In which he was advised that their daughter left Pennsylvania with Igor Vaganov and went to Dallas, Texas. He implied that Vaganov was up to something terrible and did not doubt that he was involved in the assassination of former President Kennedy.

On December 23, 1963, inquiry was made of the FBI, Fhiladelphia, to determine if they had conducted investigation in this case. SA Blaze Tomasoni advised that Mrs. Cukowski had been interviewed and it appears that she is upset because her 18 year old daughter ran away with Vaganov and got married and went to Texas. She states she does not like Vaganov and there is "something about him" that she doesn't trust. It appears that the FBI, Philadelphia, is discounting the allegations of Mrs. Cukowski and could establish no connection between this incident and the assassination.

Case closed Philadelphia.
