with *Nov 2*, 1963, without consent and without warrant or process of
law, and not having any reasonable grounds for believing he had committed any
criminal offense or no crime having been committed in the presence of the police
officers, wrongfully arrested him; that said police officer searched your
petitioner and his auto and wrongfully seized the following property
which he intends to use as evidence against him, to wit: a *hunting*
