I went to visit that publisher who publishes other assassination books but he wasn't in. I left my address so if he doesn't contact me I'll try again next week.

I found out this evening Mr. Pilger has been trying to get a hold of me by phone so I'll try and get him tomorrow.

I'm one of my classes there is a man when I sometimes discuss the assassination with - he notices my work you look and he's pretty interested in reading it. I found out yesterday he works for the CIA! He has a lot of doubts about the Warren Commission's had them. Tell me what you think of a President but he's going to meet you next time. Also if you could please send me two more copies of "The Assassination". I've got a regular library going (has and I want an extra one in case the publisher changes like to read a letter at it.
