Dear Harold:

This will be a brief letter.

I'm enclosing xerox copies of items I think you should be aware of (I don't necessarily agree with some statements in the articles but at least you'll get an idea of what is being written about).

Regarding my stay in Washington, D.C.: You'll recall that you asked about the possible time I could see and I mentioned either "late" Sunday (Oct. 20th) or "early" Monday (Oct. 21). It appears that late Sunday may not be the best time for me and you because it is very unlikely we'd get there well before 5pm (which is what you requested).
