Dear Hal:

Just a few items I wanted to call to your attention.
First, there's the enclosed column by Liz Smith (the Hollywood gossip columnist). Note the reference to the Noel Twyman book, "Bloody Treason" and the comments by Jack Valenti. I don't know which is worse: the comments by Twyman in his book or Valenti's comments here!

By the way in this very same column by Smith at the beginning, there's a reference to a new movie "Way the Dog" which stars Robert Di Niro among others. The movie is about a (fictional) President facing a sex scandal charge and what he does to get out from under it all. Di Niro (who also co-produced the film) plays a rogue kind of agent apparently close to the CIA and his "job" is to create a "diversion" so the American people won't have to concentrate on the shenanigans of the President. Di Niro's "brilliant" idea: he comes up with a fake war against Albania and hires a movie mogul producer to feed the

public a phony war with television images. The movie ends with a dead "hero" and a not-so-faked death of the movie producer (who threatens to reveal all after the fictional President wins the election).

This is probably what passes for "high culture" in Hollywood these days but there is one amusing line uttered by Di Niro in the movie I know you'll get a kick out of. It happens when Di Niro is trying to explain how easy it would be to put over a con job on the American public and get away with. Di Niro says: "Look at the first draft of the Warren Report - they tried to pin it on a drunk driver." (I saw the movie & I was the only one in the audience who laughed out loud - probably because most didn't get it or many didn't even know what the Warren Report was all about).

So much for Hollywood and its shenanigans but speaking about shenanigans Harry Livingstone called me this past week-end. He had heard that I had written a highly critical report on the Turman/Fetzer twin efforts. And if Rose can ask Shackelford to do a piece it is very strong evidence Rose will publish my piece. Even Harry thought Rose would do my article & I told Harry that I don't agree with Livingstone's thesis at all & he knows I don't.

Well, we'll see what happens in the near future.
