in the cold war. He really was a war-lover, a very, very right-wing boy from a very Catholic family; we can thank Cardinal Spellman for a good bit of the Vietnam War. Jack wanted to be a great President, and he'd figured out that the great Presidents were war Presidents."

Vidal on breeding: "No, I don't wish that I had any [children] when I see what friends have gone through. I do think that at about 40 a man—in my case briefly—sometimes wishes that he could pass on what he has learned to a son; this is doubtless innate. But my son would probably be a computer analyst and I am computer-challenged."

On not meeting his cousin, Vice President Gore: "I can't say I like the company he keeps, from Marty Peretz—Israel's uncrowned queen—to the late Armand Hammer. On the other hand, his father is a noble soul. Do I want to meet Junior? I've met too many vice presidents as it is."
