INFORMATION POSSIBLY PERTAINING TO THE KENNEDY ASSASSINATION

In the spring of 1973, while a member of the Office of National Narcotics Intelligence, I heard a story related by Mr. Christopher J. Vizas, another member of the staff whom I believe is a former FBI agent, in which the "Kennedy assassination" was mentioned. The gist of the story was that an acquaintance of his, another FBI agent, was "chewed out" by Hoover because of his mishandling of information that may have prevented the "Kennedy assassination." (I assumed he was talking about the presidential assassination, not Robert Kennedy.)

I put no credence in this story until reading the attached article. I do not recall the name of the FBI agent mentioned in Mr. Vizas' story.

This information is provided to you in this form, per your recommendation, for action by appropriate investigative authorities.
