

Dear Mr. Weinberg:

It is with some trepidation that I write to you, a feeling undoubtedly shared by all on first addressing directly one whom they have admired greatly from a distance over a considerable period of time. However, as a long-time "student" of yours, I have reached a point where my study of the Kennedy assassination requires that I obtain additional materials. It is with the hope of obtaining such materials, specifically, your classic texts on the subject, that I write to you.

Although I have managed to acquire over fifty titles related to

the JFK case, I have now contacted my primary source - Larry Weinberg, a Chicago book dealer and one-time assassination researcher (and fall-bearer of Jack Ruby) who claim to have met you in some capacity related to the case, and Dave Lovett, proprietor of The President's Box Bookshop, who suggested that I write to you and kindly provided me with your address.
