Dear Mr. Williams,

When last I spoke to Mr. Taft, which was too long ago, I told him that the time was rapidly approaching when The Chief Justice would need all the friends he had. I then gave Mr. Taft a printed copy of my book WHITWASH: THE REPORT ON THE WARREN REPORT and encouraged him to read it carefully.

I have completed the draft of a sequel entitled WHITWASH II: WHO DID IT? In it and with official documentation only I tell the even more shocking story of who did the whitewashing, how it was accomplished.

This is of such a nature that I ask that if you want to be Earl Warren's friend when he really needs one you see me at your earliest possible convenience. If my judgement means anything to you, I want to impress upon you the importance I attach to this and to speed.

I would also suggest that more than Mr. Warren's interest is urgently involved here.

At the moment, I do not know when I will be in Washington, but it is probable that some time in the early part of the coming week I will be. When I am I will call your office. However, I will stop whatever I am doing and go to Washington as soon as I hear from you and can be there in not much more than an hour after you call, if you should.
