## Boston Radio Station To Interview Weisberg

A Boston radio announcer will interview a Frederick author over the air at 10:15 p.m. Thursday.

Jerry Williams, WBZ Boston radio announcer, will interview Frederick's Harold Weisberg whose most recent book is entitled "Frame Up."

Weisberg, who is known for his best seller "Whitewash" about the John F. Kennedy assassination, has written his most recent book, "Frame Up," about the assassination of the Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.

In "Frame Up," Weisberg claims James Earl Ray did not kill Dr. King and that the U. S. government used Ray as a scapegoat.

Williams will also interview the author of another book dealing with a theory of the King assassination which conflicts with Weisberg's theory.

Williams will interview Gerold Frank, author of "An American Death." Frank's book claims Ray killed Dr. King because of an obsessive hatred of Negroes, according to an article in this week's Newsweek magazine.

Weisberg complains he has not been given the opportunity to read his opponent's book because

it has not been released locally yet. He hopes to receive a copy of the book before Thursday's interview.

Weisberg also complains of the disadvantage of being interviewed over the phone while his opponent sits in the studio with the announcer, but he intends to speak on the show in spite of his objections.

Weisberg added he will appear on the Harambee TV show at 9 p.m. Wednesday on WTOP Channel 9 to discuss "Frame Up."
