Mr. BERN ROTMAN, Senior News Editor, WDSU-TV, Channel 6, New Orleans, advised that LEE HARVEY OSWALD was in the television station around August 16, 1963, at which time he was interviewed both on television and radio. He said the only contact he had with OSWALD at this time was where OSWALD was introduced to him, as OSWALD, was being given a short tour of the news office of this station.

Mr. ROTMAN stated that a short time later OSWALD called him on the telephone and stated that he was going to picket again. OSWALD then asked Mr. ROTMAN what date he would like to have OSWALD picket. Mr. ROTMAN advised OSWALD that he did not want OSWALD to picket and had no interest as to what date he did picket, but he said that if OSWALD was going to picket, the News Bureau of Channel 6 would like to be made aware of it.

Mr. ROTMAN said that the above was the only contact he had with OSWALD and he did not know OSWALD considered him friendly enough that he would put his name in an address book.

Mr. ROTMAN said that when he was contacted by OSWALD on the twlephone, OSWALD did not say where or when or whom he was going to picket.
