Dear Joe:

I enclose part of a letter from Harold Weisberg. I eliminate the personal part about his health. As you can see, he is not optimistic that you will call. I forgot to mention that he has written a short book criticizing the LaFontaine book.

Harold and I are close. I even give him car tips. But the one about his heater did not work out. He lives in the foothills above D.C.

As Harold mentions, I forgot to tell you that Sen. John Sherman Cooper also did not agree with the single bullet theory- aka the "magic bullet". Letter enclosed, from UK Archives.

I also enclose an article from 1963 about the CIA by Arthur Krock. If memory serves, Krock worked for the Courier Journal here in Louisville, at one time. It is spooky that he discusses the overthrow of an elected government in the U.S., barely 7 weeks before it actually happened. The JFK murder was a coup, we just don't know who was behind it. It certainly was not Lee Harvey Oswald. Any time a leader is killed, it changes policy, whether caused by a madman or otherwise.

I do want to make you aware of a made for TV movie that is very accurate and is sometimes shown. Called "The Missiles of October", it stars William Devane. As JFK. Made about ten years ago, it is transcript based on the tapes JFK kept. It has several interesting facts, such as the fact that JFK ordered the Jupiter missiles in Turkey removed at least five times, and the military ignored him. I like the scene where Robert McNamara, Sec. of Defense, is ordered out of the war situation room by an admiral, because he has no right to be there! True story, it actually happened.

As this article makes clear, JFK had the same type problem with CIA.

Joe, at the risk of sounding like an egomaniac, I will tell you that there are only about 20 people in the world who can competently discuss the JFK murder. The facts. I am one of them, and without a doubt, Weisberg is the leader. I can watch documentaries and pick out the lies and mistakes, and as a trial lawyer, I can separate fact from fiction. The amount of fiction and malarkey that has been written about this case is amazing. What is funny is that many of these books blend fact and

fiction, and the only accurate part about some of them is the parts they have plagiarized from Harold. This tends to give their books credibility, and only someone trained in this area can separate the fact from the fiction.

For example, many people think Jack Ruby was part of a conspiracy. However, in my research, I turned up a psychiatric profile of Ruby, which was in Sen. Cooper's archive, but not in the 26 volumes of the Warren Report. It shows how desperately mentally ill Ruby was. He thought he heard voices from the air vent of all the Jews in America being killed, because he, a Jew, had killed Oswald. Ruby could function, but he was even investigated at one time for having sex with his dog. He called her "his wife". A sick man, he administered some frontier justice, caused in part by his friendship with the Dallas police, who thought he was harmless and allowed him to watch as they transferred Oswald. They knew who he was immediately.

Whether or not you wish to have Weisberg on your show is up to you. However, I urge you to contact him and at least listen to what he has to say. Unlike many who are tops in their field, Harold is very open and friendly. He has taken me by the hand and shown me the way to research this topic.

It is difficult to overstate the importance of Weisberg and his research. Most colleges and especially history departments ridicule those of us who labor in this field. This is caused in part by all the fiction that has been written about it, and partly by their own ignorance. But I can assure you, we are very serious about it, and dedicated to the facts. This is a case of fact being stranger than any fiction. And as your callers noted, many, many do not believe the official fiction that Oswald, acting alone and without motive, killed JFK. He clearly did not.

I hope I have been helpful and keep up the good work. I do want to point out one thing. Malcolm Kilduff, the assistant press secretary, who announced to the world that Kennedy was dead, lives in Beattyville, KY. He is a believer in the odd idea that Oswald was shooting at Gov. Connally, and missed. I have always wanted to interview him, but have not.
