Perhaps you'd like to see some of these records I referred to.

The Kat Renbach memo to "oyers was written, from other records I have, as soon as Oswald was killed and they knew there would not be any trial with the evidence subject to cross-examination. Katsenbach had no secretary that "unday afternoon so he rote it out in longhand. That and the Department of Justice file copy (File 129-11) are here along with the PBI file copy (62-109060) and the memo of the FBI assistant director who was its limison with the Department, Courtney Evans. I think it is obvious that before any real investigation was possible it was not possible to conclude that the nonexisting evidence would have led to his conviction.

The handwritten log of LBJ's Sunday 11/24 is from the Secret Service part od those records at the LBJ Hibrary, at Austin.

The CEC on the memo to Russell was his legislative assistant, Cahrles E. Campbell. I've highlighted the fact that Senator Russell, the most politically conservative of the Commissioners, was its first critic.

Thanks very much for a program that could be restricted to fact rather than what so often misleads and confuses the people, theories. There is enoug fact so that other than who the conspirators were to theorizing is necessary.
