1. Evidence that more than three bullets were fired in the Kennedy assassination.
2. WC validating FBI conclusion that Lee Harvey Oswald acted alone. *"real" lone*
3. Creation of a psychological profile for LHO to fit "lone nut" scenario. *as Hoover began,*
4. Witness credibility in identifying Oswald and his abilities as a marksman.
5. Tangible evidence at the Texas Schoolbook Depository.
6. Facts about LHO at the TSBD, including curtain rods/rifle controversy.
7. Problems with reconstruction of the assassination. *WC's & FBI is not identical*
8. Photographic evidence: Willis, Moorman, Altgens and other photos. *sketch skip* Bronson
9. Cinematic evidence: Zapruder, Muchmore, *sketch skip* Nix and other films. Bronson
10. Photo and film evidence never considered by the FBI or Warren Commission. *Autopsy & Bronson*
11. The Zapruder camera and whether it filmed the murder in slow-motion. *no*
12. Treatment of Oswald during his incarceration; what he did and didn't say. *? La Fontaines?*
13. Murder of Lee Harvey Oswald and his association with FBI, ONI and other groups. *? no proofs*
14. Jack Ruby and his association with the Dallas Police and the "mob". *essentially not real*
15. Autopsy of JFK and manipulation of evidence/participants by WC and military.
16. Suppression of evidence by Lee Rankin, Arlen Specter and others during WC. *too broad-limit*
17. Ramsay Clark's panel and manipulation of evidence in its conclusions. *not really his - with Tom P. Roche & panel*
18. Bullet fragments and FBI receipt of "missile" removed by Humes during autopsy. *skip*
19. Story of how the autopsy photos were suppressed and then restricted by Archives. *Contraint*
20. Spectrographic analysis results that excluded comparison with CE #399. *what does this mesh?*
21. Intervention of military personnel in the autopsy of President Kennedy. *controlled from start*

22. Testimony of Dr. Joseph Dolce, Army's chief consultant on wound ballistics.
23. Significance of Colonel Pierre Finck's testimony during trial of Clay Shaw.
24. Testimony by Ronald Simmons, chief of Infantry Weapons Evaluation Branch.
25. Neutron activation analysis of curbstone taken from Main Street. *none. It is spectro*
26. *not* Testimony of Pierce Allman. *SS report*
27. *Students Denton* People in Richardson, Texas and "dick rubber" documents. *one - hand. P.D.*
28. WC executive session in Jan. 64 discussing LHO's connection with the FBI. *reported 22 Feb 29*
29. Dissent of senators Russell and Cooper and its exclusion from Warren Report.
30. *rephrased* FBI/media hoax of blaming Kennedy family for obstruction of access to records.
31. Co-opting the critics: *del B* de Katzenbach memo and Earl Warren's appointment.
32. CIA reports from Mexico City and other disinformation that terrorized LBJ.
33. Results of House Select Committee on Assassinations and JFK Act.

Additional matters:

1. Critiques of *Case Closed* by Gerald Posner and *Oswald Talked* by the LaFontaines.
2. Discussion of JFK-CIA split on Cold War policy and evidence pointing toward it. *not only CIA*
3. Influence of the Cold War mindset on the Warren Commission and its report.
