
Dear Mr. Weisberg:

This letter is principally in response to your phone call of November 29, 1967 (but also to your letter of the 27th) in which you indicated that Eddie Gallaher of our staff had interviewed Mr. Josiah Thompson on a NEWSDAY program in mid-November. During our conversation I informed you that Mr. Gallaher had not interviewed such a person. Although we see no reason why Mr. Gallaher should not have done so, I have checked and the broadcast did not involve Mr. Gallaher.

If the last sentence in the first paragraph of your letter is intended to mean that your work was criticized in this program, such does not happen to have been the case.

As to the rest of your letter, we have repeatedly discussed the general matter with you, and we see no point in prolonging the discussion.
