Dear Mr. Kennedy:

At your time, this Commission was established by President Johnson on November 25, 1963, to investigate and report upon the facts and circumstances relating to the assassination of our late President, John F. Kennedy, and the subsequent killing of the alleged assassin, Lee Harvey Oswald. Enclosed are your information and copies of Executive Order No. 11130 creating this Commission, Senate Resolution 137 and the Rules of Procedure of this Commission for the taking of testimony.

Mr. James P. Blatt Jr., a member of the Advisory Staff of the Presidential Commission has been authorized by the Commission to take your deposition or an affidavit from you at the office of the United States Attorney, Dallas, Texas on June 27, 1968, at 9:00 a.m. to determine what facts you may have concerning the assassination of Mr. L. H. Oswald, and the connection of Jack Ruby with this event.

Please bring with you any notes made in connection with the events on November 22 to 24, 1963, including any personal knowledge that you may have unto within a month of those dates in preparing to record your own experiences and observations. Please also bring with you the business card sent you recently from Jack Ruby during that period.

In view of the fact if upon receipt of this letter you would confirm your appearance at the time suggested by contacting Mr. Justice for Security, Assistant U. S. Attorney, Office of the United States Attorney, Dallas, Texas.

The Commission is entitled to pay your transportation expenses incurred as a result of your appearance before Mr. Blatt.

Thank you for your cooperation in the work of the Commission.
