Dear General Walker:

At Mr. Liebler's request I enclose a photostatic copy of the transcript of the testimony which you gave to this Commission on July 23, 1964 which you may keep for your records. The enclosed copy reflects changes made by you in Dallas as well as those subsequently entered by Mr. Liebler.

The only significant change made by Mr. Liebler appears at page 128 of the enclosed transcript. He has there inserted Rider 129A to reflect statements which you made to Assistant United States Attorney Martha Joe Stroud to the effect that Duff had never implicated himself in the attack on you by statements which he made to the daughter of the woman who apparently called Mrs. Knecht of your office. I trust that you will find the attached copy of your testimony satisfactory.

In the absence of any communication from you we shall assume that the changes are satisfactory to you and we shall include your transcript in our final report in the form of the transcript enclosed.
