When the President's Commission was made CONFIDENTIAL instead of TOP SECRET. and we stopped
logging in takes from the reporters covering the
proceedings my troubles just started. The
Commission wishes that they be sent the notes so
that all will be in their possession. We destroy
carbon and waste. For the moment we are retaining
the masters.

This morning I picked up the masters, carbon and notes from the 2nd floor safe. There were at immaxideast 7 takes of notes. The first take was marked firshein - April 15-64 - President's Comm - done.

3 other takes were identified as "2", "3" & "4", nothing else. 3 other takes had no markings at all. I presume they were Mills Canton.

Can't we get takes properly marked? I don't mind doing it downstairs -- but can't see why I should. Each take should be properly marked.
