USA BAREFOOT SANDERS telephonically advised 10:15 AM this date that he had received a call from Mr. JOHN MARTIN, JR., Superintendent of Training, U. S. Post Office Terminal Annex, Dallas, advising that he was standing near the reflection pool at the time the President was shot. He stated he had taken film of the motorcade; however, the film did not show the shooting of the President. MARTIN told the USA that he was positive the shots came from the Texas School Book building and that he had so informed an unnamed police officer of this fact. He reportedly suggested to this police officer that the Texas School Book Depository be surrounded.

USA SANDERS advised that this information is known to the Commission representatives in Dallas, and they stated they would not interview MARTIN if we so desired to interview him. USA SANDERS was advised that MARTIN would be interviewed by the FBI. In line with the interview, USA SANDERS stated that the Commission representatives had requested a copy of the results be furnished them in Dallas. Prior to furnishing the copies of such interview, this should be cleared with the Bureau.
