SUBJECT: Hotel Rooms Occupied by Lee Harvey OSWALD

Cordelia:

1. The ~~draft~~ paper on Kgb operations against foreign tourists given to me on mats by C/SR for publication on Tuesday contained the following info:

Rm 233, Hotel Metropole, Moscow -- equipped with infra-red camera for observation of occupants.

Room 320, Hotel Berlin, Moscow --- equipped with overhead "vizier" (visual observation post).

Both of these rooms were occupied by Lee Harvey OSWALD during his sojourn in Moscow in the fall of 1959. Unless the info has otherwise gone to the Warren Commission, it should go now, I believe.
