Earl Warren Says Clean Air Is Not Enough

Former Supreme Court chief Justice Earl Warren said yesterday clean air and pure water will not save the nation if the government is tainted.

In remarks at Johns Hopkins University, the former jurist said even if the environment is cleansed "life for Americans will still be intolerable if we should be left with a tainted governmental structure—one without a political morality strong enough to preserve the individual and collective rights underwritten by the Constitution."
