A full - fledged four hour talk show featuring three members of the Warren Commission on KCBS Monday, October 17, 1966 failed to materialize. They cancelled out just two days before their scheduled appearance on the Harve Morgan "Contact" program.

The would - be panelists explained that they needed more time. "We recognize we have to answer the criticisms of the Warren Report," they told a CBS producer. "But we want to be well prepared."

The CBS man said he felt he was getting the run - around from the Commission. He said he thought they would eventually appear but he was "getting tired" of arranging this particular show.

He explained that the panelists had now requested that questions be submitted in advance before they appear.

The CBS man contrasted the Commission's reluctance to appear with Mark Lane's eagerness to appear. Lane took only one day to accept an invitation, when he appeared Oct. 14.
