## (250) WHAT THEY SAID

WASHINGTON, NOV. 24 (AP)--HERE ARE SOME KEY QUOTES FROM TESTIMONY TAKEN BY THE WARREN COMMISSION IN ITS INVESTIGATION OF THE ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY:

JACQUELINE KENNEDY--"I HEARD THOSE TERRIBLE NOISES, YOU KNOW. AND MY HUSBAND NEVER MADE ANY SOUND."

LYNDON B. JOHNSON--"I COULD NOT BELIEVE NOW THAT HE WAS DEAD. I WAS SHOCKED AND SICKENED."

MRS. JOHNSON (TO MRS. KENNEDY)--"YOU KNOW, WE NEVER EVEN WANTED TO BE VICE PRESIDENT AND NOW, DEAR GOD, IT HAS COME TO THIS."

MARINA OSWALD (AFTER SEEING HER HUSBAND, LEE HARVEY OSWALD, AT THE POLICE STATION)--"HE SAID THAT I SHOULD NOT WORRY, THAT EVERYTHING WOULD TURN OUT WELL. BUT I COULD SEE BY HIS EYES HE WAS GUILTY."

SEN. RALPH YARBOROUGH, D-TEX.--"I AM AMAZED AT THE LACK OF INSTANTANEOUS RESPONSE OF THE SECRET SERVICE WHEN THE RIFLE FIRE BEGAN."

JAMES J. ROWLEY, SECRET SERVICE CHIEF--"I DON'T BELIEVE THEY (THE AGENTS ON THE TRIP) COULD HAVE PREVENTED THE ASSASSINATION."

JACK RUBY--"I GUESS I JUST HAD TO SHOW THE WORLD A JEW HAS GUTS."

GOV. JOHN B. CONNALLY OF TEXAS--"ONCE I HEARD THE SHOT . . . THE ONLY THOUGHT THAT CROSSED MY MIND WAS THAT THIS IS AN ASSASSINATION ATTEMPT."

MRS. JOHN B. CONNALLY--". . . I WONDERED IF ALL THE DOCTORS WERE IN THE ROOM ON THE LEFT (WHERE KENNEDY WAS BEING TREATED) AND THEY WERE NOT TAKING TOO GOOD CARE OF MY HUSBAND ON THE RIGHT . . ."

LEE OSWALD--"I HIT THE OFFICER IN THE (MOTION PICTURE) SHOW . . . AND I GUESS HE DESERVED IT. THAT IS THE ONLY LAW I VIOLATED. THAT IS THE ONLY THING I HAVE DONE WRONG."
