Dear George,

Thanks for the loan of the HSCA's autopsy press stuff. I'd hoped it included glossys for better slides.

I also enclose my recent exchanges with Blakey. Perhaps it will amuse you.

The assassins have re-subpoenaed John Ray for 11/30. I think service was by Mel Waxman. The account I have is one of his attracting maximum attention where John now works, sort of pressure on the employer.

There is an immunizing hearing before Bryant on the 8th.

After John denied participating in any bank robberies the HSCA sent him a proposed "biography" in which they ask him to admit to a series of bank robberies, including that of the Bank of Aton, one at Hawthorne, Fla. and one they've also asked Jerry to bio. himself into.

John's imputed career of successful bank robberies, HSCA style, had him in one less than a month before his arrest on the St. Peters robbery. His supposed part in it so enriched him that he was unable to pay a lawyer. This is now Stoner got into his case.

We also have from the HSCA its investigation of John's bank accounts. They show his balance was so small that carrying charges consumed it while he was in jail.

If it interests you I have Oliver Patterson's executive session testimony. I've given Jim a copy. I'm getting the 180 pp. transcript of the HSCA's self-investigation of the Patterson charges. as with this transcript of the ex. sess., of which Jim has a copy, I'll be giving him a copy of the self-investigation. If you want copies I'll provide them but if you have only slight interest, if any, it would be easier here if you examine Jim's copies.
